## Medway Watersports Trust Changing Rooms

---

### project description



To fit out changing rooms following relocation to the river site as Medway Council required the current facilities for Duke Of Edinburgh scheme. The Trust has purchased a portacabin currently fitted as toilets and will refit these as boys and girls changing rooms and toilets as soon as funds are available. The trust's charitable objectives are to provide water sports facilities for the youth of Medway to encourage them to take up the sports and learn the skills necessary for safe participation including qualifications.

### project objectives

- To strip out and reuse the current fittings and provide new fittings to complete project.
- To re-establish the youth sailing and scout/guide sailing at weekends.
- To provide schools and organizations a venue for river water sports during the week.

---

### how could your project be achieved using a Community Award?

The Community award would provide the equipment and electrical works to carry out the project with volunteer labour.

---

### how would this money make a difference to your community?

It would secure the provision of outdoor education at the Strand Medway following the withdrawal of financial support by Medway Council due to budget constraints. The Trust has operated the centre for the previous five seasons with help from the Council but is now on their own, having been donated the sailing equipment by the Council. This would impact over 4,000 children and young people from the local area every year.



## 1 - register for an account

- Select "register" again.





## 2 - verify your email address
